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

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

Hold the thread down with the left thumb and insert the needle to the right and level of

Make a stitch on a downward angle so that the needle emerges between the two points as illustrated.	
With the thread wrapped under the needle, pull it through the fabric.	
Secure the 'V' in position with a small vertical straight stitch.	
Uses for this stitch: Can be used in foliage and to create patterns

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
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
